Drawing Composition will focus on helping the artist practice and perfect drawing skills. We will work on balance and proportion, unity and contrast, and placement. Participants will understand how to create and arrange their composition to be visually pleasing for showcase and display. Most of our work will be in black and white, but for later projects participants may bring colored pencils if they would like to add color. Participants are responsible for bringing their own

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12 SUPPLIES NEEDED: None

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

This class is exclusively for participants who did not take it during the previous session. This class will train participants to provide first aid and CPR, how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED) and STOP THE BLEED® techniques. Participants will learn critical skills needed to respond to and manage an emergency until emergency medical services arrive. Topics to be covered will include medical emergencies, injury emergencies, environmental emergencies, preventing illness and injury, adult/child CPR and AED use, infant CPR, and opioid-associated life-threatening emergencies. Participants will also learn three quick techniques in the STOP THE BLEED® portion to help save a life before someone bleeds out: (1) How to use your hands to apply pressure to a wound; (2) How to pack a wound to control bleeding; (3) How to correctly apply a tourniquet.

Participants will have the opportunity to receive an AHA Heartsaver First Aid and CPR course completion card as well as a STOP THE BLEED® completion certificate at no additional cost. Please wear loose, comfortable clothing. Participants will be practicing skills that require working on their hands and knees, bending, standing, and lifting as well as covering some sensitive topics with images showing emergency situations. Please be cautious of this prior to registering for the class.
