**ART: 1, 2, 3 . . . CREATE**

MENTOR: Alice Doane

AGE: 5yrs – 8yrs

CLASS TIME: 9:00-9:50am

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$35 per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$15 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Paint shirt, smock, or apron.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

In this class participants will create a variety of art projects that will allow them to express their individuality. They will also practice fine motor skills like tracing, cutting, and using a ruler. We will be drawing, painting, cutting, gluing, and using lots of imagination. This class will get messy, so please bring a paint shirt, smock or apron each week. *\*I will be asking for volunteer parents to assist with this class. A sign-up sheet will be available at registration.* Participants will be able to display up to 2 art pieces at the End of Session Program.

**ART: GENERAL ART**

MENTOR: Alice Doane

AGE: 8yrs – 11yrs

CLASS TIME: 3:00-3:50pm

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$35 per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$15 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 15

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Paint shirt, smock, or apron.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

This class will stretch the artist's imagination. We will create art using a variety of art mediums. Participants will draw with pencils, design with pen, paint with both watercolor and acrylic. We will also create 3D art projects using dough and string. Participants will be able to display up to 2 art pieces at the End of Session Program.

**ART: HIGHSCHOOL COLOR**

AGE: 14yrs - 12<sup>th</sup> grade

CLASS TIME: 12:00 - 12:50pm

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$35 per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$7 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 20

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Drawing pencil(s), eraser(s), a ruler, a pad or loose drawing paper and watercolor paper in 8x10, 9x12, or 11x14, canvas paper or board canvas in 8x10, 9x12, or 11x14, colored pencils (minimum of 12), Watercolor paints and paintbrushes, Acrylic paints (minimum of yellow, magenta, light blue, violet, green, and red - NO Black or Metallic paints).

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

This class will focus on color theory and color blending to create fine art pieces. Participants will use colored pencils, watercolor, and acrylic paint. Participants are responsible for bringing their own supplies each week to class. Participants will be able to display up to 2 art pieces at the End of Session Program.

**ART: INTRODUCTION TO ANIMATION (DIGITAL 2D ANIMATION)**

AGE: 12yrs – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

CLASS TIME: 11:00-11:50am

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$50 per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: None

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Participants must bring iPad or Android tablet, with an Apple Pencil or stylus! (A big phone with a stylus is possible, but not highly recommended.) Please download the “FlipaClip” animation app, prior to the first class. The app is free to download; however, if you would like the ads removed, as well as access to some of the additional features, then you have the option to pay (not required) \$29.99/year for the app.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

Using a simple app, we’ll be learning the basics of how to digitally animate and bring your drawings to life! Participants will learn how to:

- Understand the fundamentals of 2D animation.
- Learn how to navigate through this digital animation app.
- Give YOUR drawings movement!
- Properly use movement and weight to make your animations’ actions look more realistic and life-like.

SUPPLY FEE: \$7 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 20

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Drawing pencil(s), eraser(s), a ruler, a pad or loose watercolor paper in 8x10, 9x12, or 11x14, canvas paper or board canvas in 8x10, 9x12, or 11x14, Watercolor paints and paintbrushes, Acrylic paints (minimum of yellow, magenta, light blue, violet, green, and red - NO Black or Metallic paints).

**PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM:** Yes

This painting class for participants 11 years old and above will allow artists to sharpen their skill in watercolor and acrylic paint. They will be given a variety of assignments to help them practice color blending and create beautiful pieces of art. Participants are responsible for bringing their own supplies each week to class. Participants will be able to display up to 2 art pieces at the End of Session Program.

This is a breakfast Bible study. Participants will eat breakfast together while discussing disco and the book of Ecclesiastes. Participants are responsible for bringing their own nut free breakfast.

SUPPLY FEE: \$2 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 20

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Bible, pen or pencil, notebook or paper for taking notes and lunch

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

This is a lunch break Bible study. Participants will eat lunch together while studying God's word and the book of Ephesians. Participants are responsible for bringing their own, nut free, lunch.

**DANCE: BALLET**

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Girls: Black leotard, pink tights, black or light pink skirt, nude or light pink ballet shoes. Boys: White T-shirt, black pants-like joggers, black or tan ballet shoes, black or white socks. Ballet shoes should be able to bend in half and NOT have a hard sole. Hair should be up and out of faces.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

If you are 9 yrs old or older, previously taken ballet from me or someone else, and/or want to continue learning and sharpening your ballet skills & technique, this is the ballet class for you! (If you are 10+ yrs old with no previous experience, no worries...you will also enjoy practicing and learning at this level.) In this class, we will continue to work on flexibility, review and learn new ballet steps, and spend time building strength and technique necessary for ballet. Participants will also learn a dance to perform at the End of Session Program. Because participants will be learning a dance, they need to be able to attend as many classes as possible so they can memorize their dance. Please make sure they use the restroom before class and bring a water bottle with them. Participants must be able to listen, participate, and practice at home.

TUITION FEE: \$60 per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$5 per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

**SUPPLIES NEEDED:** Girls: Black leotard, pink tights, black or light pink skirt, nude or light pink ballet shoes. Boys: White T-shirt, black pants-like joggers, black or tan ballet shoes, black or white socks. Ballet shoes should be able to bend in half and NOT have a hard sole. Hair should be up and out of faces.  
**PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM:** Yes

In this class, participants will learn the basics of ballet and some of the stories told through ballet. We will review and pick up where we left off last session. If your participant is 6 yrs old, I would like them to have 1 or more sessions of experience. If your participant is 7 or older, previous experience is not necessary. Participants will improve flexibility, grace, barre, and center skills. Participants will also learn a dance to perform at the End of Session Program. Because participants will be learning a dance, they need to be able to attend as many classes as possible so they can memorize their dance.
