This session, we will explore topics such as:

- How our brain and body respond to fear and triggers

- Why we react the way we do and how to respond with purpose
- Tools for identifying and managing thoughts, feelings, and behaviors
- Philosophical and Biblical reflections on identity and meaning.

With weekly journaling, class discussions, and interactive activities, participants will not only uncover why they think and feel the way they do, but also how to align those thoughts with truth, anchoring their identity in Christ. Some occasional take-home assignments will be given. *Important Notes for Parents:* This course will include discussion on sensitive topics such as mental health disorders, suicide, and abortion from a Biblical perspective. I am a licensed paramedic, certified in mental health first aid, trained in group/individual critical incident stress, and am a part of my EMS Peer Support Team. While these subjects will be approached with care and discernment, I ask that parents ensure their participant is emotionally and mentally ready to engage in these conversations with maturity and thoughtfulness.
