ART: ART THROUGH THE SEASONS

MENTOR: Alice Doane

AGE: 8yrs – 11yrs

PREREQUISITE: No

CLASS TIME: 10:00am – 10:50am

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$40/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$15/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Old t-shirt, apron, or smock suggested on some days.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

Participants in this class will create art representing the four seasons: Winter, Summer, Spring, and Fall (even if Evansville only gets 2). We will be using colored pencils, pens, glue, watercolor, and dough to create fun projects giving participants a taste of a variety of art styles and mediums. Each participant will be allowed to display 1 or 2 works assigned in class at the End of Session Program.

ART: CHARACTER MAKEUP 101

MENTOR: Bekah Kelle

AGE: 12yrs – 12th grade

PREREQUISITE: No

CLASS TIME: 1:00pm – 1:50pm

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$35/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$20/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Apron or old shirt, pack(s) of 24 or more makeup wipes/baby wipes that work well with your participant's skin. These items will need to be brought to class each week.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

In this class, participants will learn and further grow skills in this art form that can be used in theatre, film, character creating, etc. Your participant will learn the art of makeup through practicing looks such as face shaping, fur, scales, scars and bruises, old age and more. We will also talk about "makeup etiquette" and the importance of it when working with the products we will be using. The majority of the time, your participant will be practicing these skills on a practice mannequin made for makeup, however, there will be a few times that the makeup will be on the participant's skin. Please take into consideration that I will be teaching how to make realistic cuts and bruises in this class. I understand that these

topics can make people uncomfortable. I will talk about the importance of them but will not be glorifying violence or gore in any way. The participants in this class will be helping with makeup for the C.H.O.I.C.E Theatre performance at the End of Session Program.

Bekah has been a C.H.O.I.C.E. participant for over 9 years. Last year, she had the blessing of leading a makeup crew on an Academy of Arts Drama Seminar Team and has had experience assisting in makeup with various productions over the past 6 years.

ART: COLOR THEORY AND DRAWING

MENTOR: Alice Doane

AGE: 11yrs – 12th grade

PREREQUISITE: No

CLASS TIME: 11:00am – 11:50am

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$40/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$5/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 20

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Drawing pad or drawing paper 8x10 or 9x12, eraser, 3 or more drawing pencils (at least 1 H, an HB, and at least 1 B), Pencil sharpener. Colored pencils (minimum 12 colors, Black and metallic colors will not be allowed in class).

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

This class will teach color theory and drawing basics. Participants will dive into color theory to help them understand and master color. We will also practice drawing from life and from photos. Participants will learn to sketch, shade, and finish fine art pieces in pencil and in colored pencil. This class is a prerequisite for other middle school and high school classes.

Participants will need to bring their own supplies each week. Each participant will be allowed to display 1 or 2 works *assigned in class* at the End of Session Program.

ART: CREATION STATION: ART AND CRAFT EXPLORATION

If you love to create, experiment, and build cool things from scratch, this is your zone. In this class, we break away from standard drawing and painting to explore the wide world of crafting. ART: DRAWING FROM LIFE

MENTOR: Alice Doane

AGE: 13yrs – 12th grade

PREREQUISITE: Participants must have taken Drawing, Middle School Art, Visual Art, or Fundamentals

CLASS TIME: 9:00am – 9:50am

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$40/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$5/per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 15

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Drawing pad or drawing paper 8x10 or 9x12, eraser, 3 or more drawing pencils (at least 1 H, an HB, and at least 1 B), Pencil sharpener. Participants may choose to bring colored pencils later in the session but are not required.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: Yes

This class is for the serious artist. Participants will practice drawing and sketching with a series of exercises and prompts that are designed to improve and challenge the artist. We will work from still life and draw live models. ***Participants are responsible for bringing their own supplies each week.*** Each participant will be allowed to display 1 or 2 works *assigned in class* at the End of Session Program.

Help wanted: In need of volunteer(s) for 3 live model positions. Model(s) will need to be able to sit or stand still for 45 minutes while being sketched and be available weeks 6, 7, and/or 8. This can be anyone not taking this class from age 14 to 99.

BIBLE: WALKING IN THE SPIRIT, NOT TRYING HARDER

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session/50 minutes each week

SUPPLY FEE: \$15/per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 15

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Bible, pen/pencil, three-ring binder/notebook, three-hole lined paper

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

TUITION FEE: \$15/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$2/per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 20

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Bible, notebook, pencil, and lunch

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (Matthew 11:28-30) This is a lunch break Bible study. In this class we will read and study the teachings of Jesus. Participants will discuss His sermons and His discussions with His disciples while learning what this means for us today. Participants are responsible for bringing their own, peanut free, lunch.

DANCE: BALLET

TUITION FEE: \$60/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$5/per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Girls leotard, tights or leggings, ballet slippers (preferably pink). Boys: T-shirt, black pants-like joggers, black or tan ballet shoes. Ballet shoes should be able to bend in half and NOT have a hard sole. Hair should be up and off of the face.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

We will follow a typical ballet class structure as we review and learn new ballet steps and continue to work on flexibility, strength, and techniques necessary for ballet. While we will build on choreography throughout the session to create "mini dances" within class, participants will NOT be performing at the end of this session, spending more time in class learning, practicing more in depth, and having fun without the performance aspect this time. Please make sure they use the restroom BEFORE class and bring a water bottle with them. ***Participant expectations:*** Participants must be able to listen, participate, and practice at home. SUPPLIES NEEDED: Comfortable, modest exercise-type clothes that allow for ease of movement. Shoes that are comfortable.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

Ever feel awkward or unsure at formal dances or weddings because you don't know the group dances? Want to build confidence and coordination? Or just want to learn for fun?! (It is so much more fun than running for your cardio...) This session, we will learn and practice common popular group line dance songs played at homeschool formals, weddings, and other social gatherings. CLASS TIME: 2:00pm – 2:50pm

CLASS LENGTH: 12-week session /50 minutes each week

TUITION FEE: \$60/per participant for 12-week session (cash only/exact change due on first day of class)

SUPPLY FEE: \$10/per participant (cash only/exact change due at registration)

MINIMUM: 4 MAXIMUM: 12

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Black tap shoes, comfortable dance or athletic type clothing.

PERFORMING/DISPLAYING AT END OF SESSION PROGRAM: No

Join us as we have fun learning the art and sounds of tap dancing to varying music! No prior experience necessary. (If you have experience, that is great too!) I encourage interested participants to join in whether you've taken this class before or not. While we'll learn/review basics, we will continue to grow and challenge ourselves with new steps and rhythms. The more we practice (even the basics), the more we can develop our style.
